Basis for participation

Those interested will send summaries of dissertation proposals that will be evaluated according to scientific and practical contribution to the thematic areas of the ACACIA contribution. The summary of the proposal needs to be sending on **March 20, 2017** and accepted only those who invariably follow the following processes:

I. The student must complete the speakers registration form directly on the electronic platform of the congress: <http://www.acaciavallarta2017.com> on the menu: Presentations / Speaker to the symposium to create a password; subsequently, it is essential to confirm your registration by clicking the link that will come to your mail.

II. The information provided in the registration will be taken to issue the certificates and all processes monitoring and control of the symposium; so it is very important to carefully fill out correctly and completely each of the required fields. Please always use your name in the same way (without initials and with the same score). All this is necessary to achieve better efficiency in databases.

III. Once confirmed your registration, you can access the platform with the password (username and password) that you will get in your mail and proceed to attach the summary on the congress website: <http://www.acaciavallarta2017.com/> in the menu: Presentations / Send the symposium; according to the following specifications: The abstract should be structured in at least 800 words and contain the following: 1. Title of research 2. Select the Frame in which your Dissertation proposal is more related. (See chapters in the previous section) 3. Name of author 4. Institution Represented 5. Full address and telephone 6. Email 7. Summary of Content a) Research Objectives b). theoretical framework c). Methodology d). Implications / limitations e). Originality / value 8. Keywords (5)

After reviewing the relevance of the summary, the response by the organizing committee regarding acceptance or rejection of project shall be on **April 3rd, 2017**, according to the date on which the summary was sent. Students accepted will be invited to submit their

research proposal which will participate in the symposium which will be analyzed and will receive feedback by two academics.

The requirements for the proposals are:

1. Title of research
2. Chapter in which it participates
3. Student Name
4. Institution affiliation, full address, phone and email
5. Content of the proposal: a) Justification of the relevance of research b) Research questions c) Research Objectives (general and specific) d) Theoretical framework e) Research Hypothesis (if it exist) f) Description of the methodological approach selected g) partial results and / or expectations
6. References
7. Annexes

The maximum length of the proposal is 30 pages, considering cover, graphs, tables, references and any attachments.

The research proposal must be submitted no later than **April 30, 2017** through the website in the menu: Presentations / Monitoring Symposium. Costs and all information necessary to facilitate registration and participation will be available in the Support section (registration costs, accommodation, FAQs). Mail: coloquio.acacia2017@univa.mx will be available for any questions about it.

Form requirements for summary and proposal: 1. Use Word (2007-2013) as word processor: save files with extension (.docx). 2. Arial 12 point, 1.5 line spacing and 2.5 margins on all sides, 3. Use APA format in its latest edition for citations and references.

The official languages of the colloquium are: Spanish, French and English; Therefore, you can send jobs in any of these three languages. The presentation (presentation) of the presentation may also be in any of the three languages (Spanish, English and French).
